What will you be doing?

- Building a digital transformation network within your area of the county focused on supporting general practice and PCNs to realise the full benefits of existing digital systems.
- Providing peer support and a coaching environment to facilitate increased utilisation of digital by practice/PCN teams and patients.
- Build effective and trusted working relationships with general practice and PCN Digital and Transformation leads within Devon.
- Guide and collaborate with surgeries/PCNs on their own individual transformation journeys using best practices from across the country.
- Champion transformational change within general practice, supporting practices and PCNs through change adoption and transformation.

- Identify both digital and non-digital barriers to change within primary care and work with practices and ICB change capacity to overcome these.
